# FORECAST SHARP INCREASE IN CARS, STATE POPULATION

STATE POPULATION

Michigan's population of registered passenger cars will increase by more than 1,732,000 and there will be a gain of 512,000 families in the state by 1965, according to a study by a leading independent automobile finance company.

Passenger car registrations by 1965 should total more than 1,739,000, a 71 per cent increase over the 2,447,000 now registered. The finance company also forecast a population gain of about 25 per cent, or more than 1,755,000 persons, by 1965. This would bring the states population to more than 3,825,000 A for fam is expected, vasting the tital to more than 2,865,000 as compared with about 2,053,000 and title now.




