Township Board

(Continued from Page 1A) proposal.

The Board approved a resolution calling for a special election on July 25 regarding renewal of the 30-year franchise of the Consumers Power Company to operate in the Township. The entire cost of the election will be paid by the Consumers Power Company.

Leonard reported that the Circuit Court has upheld the decision of the Township to deny the issuance of a building permit for the expansion of facilities of the O. & W. Engineering Company on Ten Mile Road east of Orchard Lake Road. The Court ruled that the Company building is located in an area of non-conforming use.

A new motion was approved by the Board declaring its intent to amend the Zoning Ordinance to permit construction of homes for the aged in residential zones. The original motion, designed to make way for the construction of the Baptist Manor on Thirteen Mile Road east of Orchard Lake Road, was rejected by the Zoning Board.

Leonard stated that the petition was turned down on the theory that it would open the entire Township to this type of operation. He added that in his opinion, the clause "when permitted by the Zoning Board of Appeals" would serve to control the situation if necessary. Leonard stated that it is not his intention to influence the decision of the Zoning Board.

An attorney, representing the Glensville Civic Association, requested the Board to issue a stop order against further construction of an addition to the Western Tool & Die Company on Grand River because of alleged violation of the zoning ordinance. The Board tabled the request pending further investigation.

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LEGAL NOTICE

AN ORDINANCE, granting to Consumers Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, power and authority to lay, maintain and operate gas mains, pipes and services on, along, across, and under the highways, streets, alleys, bridges, and other public places, and to do a local gas business in the Township of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, for a period of thirty years.

Section 1. That the Township of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, hereby grants to the Consumers Power Company, a corporation authorized to transact business in Michigan, its successors and assigns, hereinafter called the "Grantee," the right, power and authority to lay, maintain and operate gas mains, pipes and services on, along, across, and under the highways, streets, alleys, bridges, and other public places, and to do a local gas business in the Township of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, for a period of thirty years.

Section 2. In consideration of the rights, power and authority hereby granted, all of which shall vest in the Grantee for a period of thirty (30) years as set forth in said Grant, said Grantee shall faithfully perform all things required by the terms hereof.

Section 3. No highway, street, alley, bridge or other public place used by said Grantee shall be obstructed longer than necessary during the work of construction or repair, and shall be restored to the same order and condition as when said work was commenced.

All of Grantee's pipes and mains shall be so placed in the highways and other public places as not to unnecessarily interfere with the use thereof for highway purposes.

Section 4. (a) Grantee shall at all times keep and save the Township free and harmless from all loss, damage and expense to the Township, its successors and assigns, in the construction and maintenance of the structures and equipment hereby authorized, in case any action is commenced against the Township on account of the permission herein given, said Grantee shall, upon notice, defend the Township and save it free and harmless from all loss, cost and damage arising out of such negligent construction and maintenance.

Section 5. The rights, power and authority herein granted, are not exclusive. Either manufacturing or natural gas may be furnished hereunder.

Section 6. Said Grantee shall from time to time extend its gas distribution system to and within said Township, and shall furnish gas to applicants residing therein whenever the amount of gas to be furnished thereby shall provide an adequate and reasonable return upon the cost of making such extensions and providing such service.

Section 7. Said Grantee shall be entitled to charge the inhabitants of said Township for gas furnished therein, the rates as shown by the schedule now on file in the office of the Township Clerk, and until the Michigan Public Service Commission or its successors, to which Commission the authority and jurisdiction to fix and regulate gas rates in said Township is hereby granted and conferred for the term of this franchise, shall fix and establish different rates, in which case the rates so fixed and established, if just and reasonable, shall prevail. Such rates shall be subject to review and change at any time upon petition therefor being made by either the said Township or by said Grantee.

Section 8. This ordinance shall cease and be of no effect after thirty days from its adoption, unless within said period the Grantee shall accept the same in writing filed with the Township Clerk, subject to confirmation of the grant hereof by at least a majority of the electors of said Township voting thereon at a regular or special township election to be held in the manner provided by law. Upon the acceptance and confirmation hereof, this ordinance shall constitute a contract between said Township and said Grantee for a period of thirty years from the date of such acceptance.

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
