

Local industry is not indestructible. This is the most important thing people should remember when thinking of community progress, says Don Weeks, director of the Michigan Economic Development Department.

Weeks says that in some cases plants close or move regardless of the local conditions. But, he adds, other Michigan areas have lost their industries when good community reliations could have prevented it. Merchant and civic groups, particularly in one payroll towns, are very wise to work with local industries, making the management feet welcome and wanted; encouraging industry personnel to take active part in community reliates.

High taxes in some istates cause industries to move out and new industries not to consider locating within their boundaries, says Weeks. He lists several eastern states as specific examples, and expresses the hope that Michigan residents will weigh the value of an industry to their communities when voting on issues which affect it.
