Large Brown Trout Netted To Be Studied

Netted To Be Studied

The largest brown trout on record in Michigan is due for careful study by the Conservation Department's institute for fisheries research at Ann Arbor. The trout—weighing 19 pounds, four ounces—was taken August 29 in Lake Michigan approximately two, miles north of Monistee by Robert Bjorquist, commerc ci al-fisherman. Bjorquist lwas fishing for walleyes when the big brown showed up in his-nets.

The 313-inch trout was turned over to the Conservation Department and analysis will be made of scales and identifiable organs.
