### Auto Power Loss Now Under Study

Power loss from piston knock may be largely overcome in the family auto through scientific study being carried on by means of a new device called a "shock

The shock tube was devised for producing fuel-air explosions that can be photographed. This shock tube is now being jused to study just what causes different fuels.
