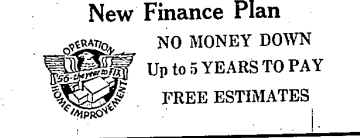

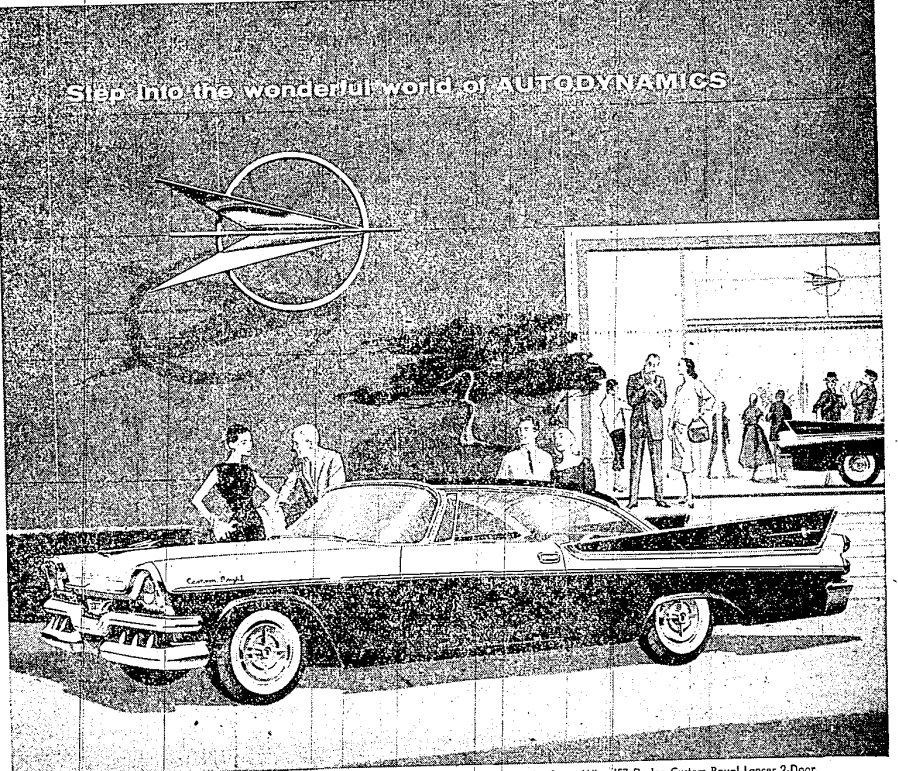
The afternoon of activities will be concluded with a banquet for the new Marygrove students and for faculty members. The junior class will hostess the affair.

Outdoor Fire Uses Still Banned In State

Hunters and others using the state are again reminded of the Governor's proclamation forbidding smoking or other use of fire in fields and forests in the southern lower peninsula.

The week's heaviest fire losses were recorded in the southern lower peninsula, where 17 fires blazed, across 103 acres. In the northern peninsula, 25 fires damaged 69 acres while 21 fires in the U. P. burned 37 acres.
