

Barbecue Venison Meal Suggested

If you enjoyed beef and chicken barbeeue, you'll undoubtedly like deer meat in the form of a venison barbeeue, say authorities. Michigan State University food specialists suggest this as one way to serve venison. Sear three pounds of venison in a frying pan 'with slices of salt pork or other fat. Cover the venison with a barbeeue sauce and roast jit in a moderate oven (330 degrees) for one and one-half to two hours. Turn it occasionally.
