THE Association proposed

that all citizens place these resolutions on their New Year's list of resolutions:

1. To learn the facts about the heart and its disease and to avoid needless fears and worries.
2. To shun self-diagnosis in favor of regular heart health checks by your own physician.
3. To guard against excessive weight, remembering that overweight overworks your heart.
4. To get the sleep and rest you need, because rest lightens the work your heart has to do.
5. To keep fit by exercising moderately and regularly. But, remember, act your age and have the physical stamina you had 10 or 20 years ago. Strenuous exercise may not harm a healthy heart, but the danger is real if your heart and circulation are not in good order.
6. To be alert to the dangers of respiratory infections which are more common in winter months, and may place an added strain on the heart. Prompt medical treatment for such infections is important, especially for "straps" through which the force-runner of rheumatic fever and rheumatic heart disease.

The Association pointed out

that hope and optimism are increasingly warranted by the dramatic advances in diagnosis, treatment, prevention and cure achieved in recent years as the result of heart research, and that heart disease was once regarded as a sentence of death or life-long invalidism. It is now recognized that some forms of heart disease can be prevented, a few can be cured, and that almost all cases can be helped by proper treatment, especially after early diagnosis. —Douglas Ferrell, M.D.
