The portion of the new U. S. 716, Expressway, by-passing Farmington, will be completed and opened to traffic in three weeks, according to John C. A contract has been awarded by the City Council to the firm of Blaska and Garlan for the appraisal of all real and personal property in the City at a bid price of \$11,000.



The petitions, which will be used to support a portion of the financing of the system, must bear the signatures of owners of at least is per cent of the land involved in each special assessment district. The area has been divided into seven special assessment
