YES Reports Jobs Found

FARMINGTON The Youth Employment Service submitted a report to the Farmington City Council Monday that kept strictly to numbers.

A two-page document, the first annual report of the employment agency supported by the two cities and the public schools, indicated 993 applicants were placed, out of a total of 1,759 applications.

"We were told 800 would be good," Director Claire Orleans said, pleased with the progress of the new agency.

A six-month report with a long verbal review of the work of the agency kicked off a controversy which threatened the funding of the program by Farmington Township last year.


The council accepted the report with little comment—they had already approved a second year's funding for the agency.

There were 148 permanent full time jobs found by the agency. They referred 1,626 applicants to job interviews.

of current events, with comments on matters ranging from the recent U.S. Supreme Court ruling on pornography to the Chapapallick affair to the effects on the economy and U.S. currency abroad of the Watergate hearings.

Speaking of Watergate, Fernandez, who concedes a "slight" leaning toward the Democratic party, said he's "waiting until all the facts are in" before arriving at an opinion.

Rather than prompting retreat from a sordid situation, the Watergate has "tempted me to possibly think that some day I might appear in the Senate and help make sure that campaign laws are applied," the young man said.

"Sure there's been corruption throughout time and not just on the federal level," he said. "We can live with it and we should not accept it and not give up entirely. That's a bad attitude in any situation."

Fernandez also sees Watergate as leading voters to scrutinize more closely the ethical and moral standards of future political candidates, particularly for the Presidency.

Instead of charisma, he said, "they'll be looking for an honest man."




