**Tocco Wins Piano Contest**

Pianist James Tocco, who is well known in Observant through guest appearances at Schoolcraft College, won first place this month in the "Piano Contest of the Americas."

The contest was held in Niteroi, Brazil.

Tocco, who is from Detroit, won fifth place in the annual Tchaikovsky Competition in Moscow in 1970.

For his latest win, Tocco played music by Chopin. He will receive \$5,000.

Tocco first appeared at Schoolcraft's summer music festival in 1970. He returned for a concert in the college's community concerts series in 1971, and was featured with the Schoolcraft String Quartet last January, in a cultural and public affairs presentation.
