Muskegon Park Has Dunes And Camping

Sand dunes, scenic Lake
Michigan shorelines, and
thick forest are the lure at
two western Michigan state
parks, but Muskegon State
Park has the edge in everything except fame and size,
according to Automobile
Club of Michigan.
Muskegon has many stimiliarities with D.H. Day State
Park near Empire, 199 milesnorth, but Muskegon has
pearly three times as many
campsites so there may be a
better chance of getting accommodations there.
Muskegon Natle Park is
four miles west of North
Muskegon NAI23. Its 1,125
acres include three miles of
sandy beach on Lake Michigan, two miles of Muskegon
Lake frontage and
three-quarters of a mile on
Muskegon channel.
Campers have 346 sites at
two locations to choose from.
One is located at the north
end of the park in a heavily
wooded area along the Lake
Michigan shoreline. This
campground has 242 sites
with modern facilities, bathhouse and a park store.
The other site is three

views over the tops of tall trees also afford a wide, sweeping view of Lake Michigan.

A boat launching site at Snug Harbor, on Lake Muskegon, provides access to the lakes and channel. Pienic sites also are available.

The park has many well-marked foot trails which make the interior interesting because of the different stands of trees covering the ancient sand dunes. Fishing in Muskegon Lake is excellent for large and smallmouth bass, bluegills, perch, pike and walleyes.

Muskegon State Park's attendance last year was 465,79, making it seventh among the 32 parks in the Michigan Department of Natural Resources Region III, which covers the southern half of the Lower Peninsula.
