The Women's Christian Temperance Federation picnic will be held on Wednesday, August 7, at Cass-Benton Park in Northville.

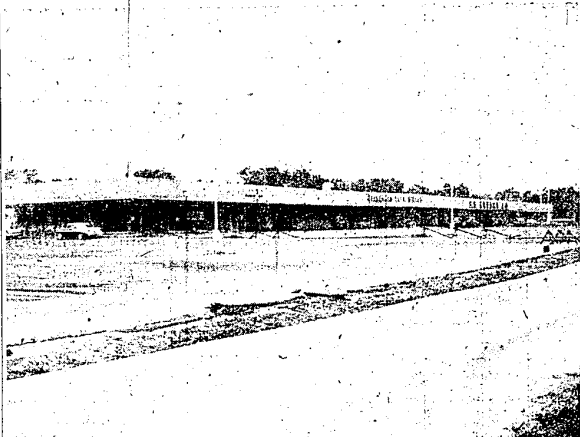

Start Work On Fourth Lane To U.S. 16 Between Farmington And Kent Lake

Highway Commissioner John Mackie reports work underway on addition of a fourth lane to U.S. 16 between Farmington and Kensington Park to speed construction which will relieve traffic congestion on this route.

Commissioner Mackie said he had arranged for Oakland County Commission maintenance crews to do the grading operations on the fourth lane. The maintenance crews, which will regularly maintain Oakland county trunklines under State contract, will supply gravel for a base preparing the fourth lane roadway for blacktopping.
