States Position On Filing For Treasurer's Job

To the Editor:

The letter from "Fair Play" in the Public Letter Box of August 29 questions why a person with no qualifications would desire a \$7,000 a year job. Perhaps it was more a matter of duty than desire.

Duty arises from a need and in my opinion our Township has reached the point where it needs a fiscal officer, someone on the order of a financial executive in industry.

The reasoning is this. The volume of finances is already large and it rapidly grows to handle the mass of routine items. They administer their departments and do some internal auditing but otherwise they set for themselves the fiscal responsibilities outlined above.

In addition, the fiscal executive makes sure that he has adequate accounts, records, procedures and a system of internal check and control, the more important the greater the volume of finances, and of great importance, that these are properly handled. Also he supervises the accounting adjustments constantly required by changing conditions and seeks improvement in time saving, reporting and faster availability of information. Except for need of no outside bookkeepers or CPA's other than for the routine annual audits conducted by independent CPA's.

That is our Township's need, in my opinion, but it is hard to find someone to fill this need. The pay is not competitive for the qualifications required. Nor is the employment stability competitive because of the risk involved in elections.
