The base salary of the principals has always been based on the teachers' salary schedule. Presently this has not changed with the exception of several points of increment arrived at for principals are independent increments.

Their base pay is still the maximum salary for teachers which this year was raised 5300 to \$5800.

Maximum salary for elementary Principals is \$12,500; Junior High School maximum 514, 000. Maximum raise is \$900.
