

Tax Hike For County Endorsed

At its regular meeting last Thursday, the Livonia School Board went on record as supporting a one-mill county tax limitation increase proposal which will be on the Sept. 1, 1964 primary ballot.

Trustee Strela Schreiber, who is also recording secretary for the Wayne County Association of School Boards, explained the purpose of the proposal and urged that Livonia voters support it at the ballot box next month.

Mrs. Schreiber moved that the Livonia Board join other school boards in Wayne County in supporting the proposal. After a short discussion the Board gave its unanimous approval.

Board Vice-President Steve Polgar raised the question of the propriety of one government unit backing another agency's legislation to obtain additional funds, but Assistant Superintendent of the District Ronald Upton assured Mr. Polgar the County needed the additional funds, and if they could not raise the extra mill to run its county-wide program the money would come from the local school board allocations. Mr. Polgar then agreed to vote "aye."

"Under the old law the County had a 15-mill limitation," Mrs. Schreiber pointed out. "Under the new constitution the limit is 18 mills. However, instead of requesting a three-mill increase the County is seeking a one-mill addition this fall."

"The County needs these additional funds. If they cannot raise the extra mill to run its county-wide program the money will have to come indirectly from local school board allocations. Having these tax monies go directly to the County is more efficient than having the funds drained away from Livonia, Farmington, Plymouth, Redford, and other school boards," concluded Mrs. Schreiber.

There are 43 school districts represented in the Wayne County Association of School Boards. In a statement sent to all participants early this month recording secretary Mrs. Schreiber wrote, "what it should be pointed out to our members that all of our districts with the exception of one have had to increase their local millages in order to meet added school costs. Attention was further called to the fact, that in appearances before the Tax Allocation Board, school people in all districts have repeatedly stressed to County officials their feeling that the County should request additional millage to meet their increased needs and added costs."

Council OK's SDM License

A new beer-and-wine retail outlet for Livonia was approved by the City Council Wednesday, and several items concerning liquor licenses were acted upon.

The Council gave the new SDM license to the Borman Food Stores, Inc., which will open a store at 23580 Seven Mile Rd. in the Livonia Mall.

Transfer of ownership of an SDM license was approved for Albert R. Talbot, who bought the license at 28760 Plymouth Rd. from Donald and Helen Zalman.


A request from Cayetano Fernandez of Redford Township and Sam Perlove of Livonia for a new Class C liquor license was referred to the Council's Committee of the Whole for discussion, by a 4-1 vote. Councilman Peter Ventura told Councilmen they should "listen" to the plans of those who request licenses, instead of automatically adding them to the list of 150 applicants.

A dance permit for the Livonian Knights Jan. 29/30 W. Seven Mile Rd. held in conjunction with the Class C license there, was approved. The Council approved transfer of stock interest from John Cipriano to Hubert Gedrich at the Pen-Mar Inn, 31735 Plymouth Rd.






