Q. I'm finishing the expansion ttic of my house and also have o re-roof soon. What sort of oofing should I use to keep the lew attic room as cool as possi-

ble?

ANSWER. White asphalt shingles will provide maximum insulating value. Since no roofing material is thick enough to offer significant insulating value because of its thickness alone, its color that counts, and white reflects the most heat away from a house.

Q. The wood clapboard on my house is badly blistered and cracked. I'm fold that painting and repairs would be very costly, with doubtful results. Can the house wall be surfaced instead with mineral fiber siding over the clapboard?

Among building terms home owners should know is the word "square." A square of roofing material is the amount needed to cover 100 square feet of roof


For instance, if shingles weighing 255 pounds per square are used, each 100 square feet of roof will be protected from weather and fire brands by that weight of covering. Longer lasting protection may be gained from "beavyweight" as phalt shingles—those weighing 250 pounds per square or more—without any contract of the protection of 25 years.

Take Steps to Keep Old Staircases Safe

Do shaky stairs give you the shakes? Occasional checkups are needed to keep the staircase in solid condition. The newel post may need reinforcing with additional screws. The handrail brackets tend to loosen and should be braced with heavier screws.
