

GROUNDBREAKING ceremonies were held last Sunday for St. Matthew's Methodist and E.U.B. Church at the site of 30900 West Six Mile Road. room for 50, a large nursery for preschoolers, a fully equipped kitchen, plus a library and private offices. A bell tower, chapel and additional classrooms will be built in the future. Livonia architect William P. Lindhout designed the building. Rev. John N. Grenfell and Rev. James A. Lange are the church pastors.
