# German Youth to Reside in Livonia

Coming to Livonia under the sponsorship of the Michigan Council of Churches will be young Ray Schuster from Hamburg, Germany.

The program called "Youth for Understanding" is a teen-age exchange program supported by Protestant churches.

Ray will be attending Bentley High School and will stay in the home of Mayor and Mrs. Harvey Moelle of Livonia.

The following is an excerpt from Ray's statement applying to being an exchange student.

"In the last years I began to be critical not only at other persons, but also at me. Inspired by the school, I try to settle a matter with the disappearance of individualism. I began to read good books and to go to the theatre. I think that this disappearance of individualism is a great danger and to know whether it is acute in the U.S.A. too."

"As America is the first country, where the idea of freedom and variety of all people is realized, I think it is most interesting to see the U.S.A. and learn more about the country."

The following is a letter received by the Moelle family on August 5, 1964.

My Dear Foster Parents:

I've received a letter today with an address, your address. I thought that it was my birthday I've had not so long ago.



## RELIGIOUS ILLITERACY

The religious illiteracy of our day was recently revealed by a questionnaire addressed to 16,434 high school students. Eighty-seven per cent of them could not name three Old Testament prophets; 54 per cent of them could not name three disciples of Jesus; and 64 per cent of them could not name the four Gospels.

Religion, we know, does not consist in a knowledge of names; yet any youth of sixteen who has been given a proper Christian training should not only know the answers to the above questions, but he should also know what the Bible says concerning sin, about Christ and His redemption, about Baptism, Holy Communion, and a dozen other fundamental facts of faith.
