

"The youth would be out of Juvenile Court for approximately six months before his license expired. If he has any adult itchets in this six months, the Secretary of State will and on those cases where there have been tickets during the six months period, the Secretary of State will request the Juvenile's traffic record from Juvenile Court. Some formula can then be developed as to whether or not he gets a new licens and when.

"The point is this. Only seven percent of juvenile drivers are chronic violators (those who get three or more moving violations a year). These are the ones we want to nail.

"I believe that the first year of driving should be considered a very special privilege and that Juvenile Court should adopt a policy of longer suspension than adult cases. I believe that there can be devised some sort of a "provisional license set-up" for juveniles that may be better than putting them

under the point system.

"I have not worked out all the details of the proposal and, therefore, I have made no public statement."
