# urroughs Awarded \$4.9 Million AF Contract

An unexpected order from the United States Air Force has employes at the Michigan Manufacturing and Engineering division of Burroughs Corporation at Plymouth conjecturing as to the expected impact on the working schedule for the next year and perhaps 18 months.

Burroughs officials, who indicated the order came as a complete surprise, wouldn't comment on the situation.

Earlier, General Manager Herbert DeBorde, in a talk at the monthly forum of the Plymouth Chamber of Commerce, had indicated the plant was working at near capacity during a changeover.

The shift workers from the Detroit plant on Second Ave. to Plymouth, under the revised plan of operations for Michigan, hasn't been completed and DeBorde at that time stated that it would probably bear much as another vear before the transfer was consumed to the property of the property

Debottee at that time stated that it would probably be as much as another year before the transfer was con-summated.

Although Burroughs' officials refused to com-ment on the amount of the order, Senators Philip Hart and Patrick McNamara sent wires to commu-

nity newspapers in the area stating that it was a two-fold order with approximately \$950,000 in the first phase and almost \$4 million in the second. The Air Force has selected Burroughs to provide 151 B263 electronic data processing systems to replace punched card accounting machines now being used in the United States and overseas installations by base sub command, major aid command and Air Force Headquarters managers.

The Air Force, in Washington, D.C., said Burroughs was selected after careful and detailed evaluation of five vendors "as providing equipment with treatest capability for the cost involved."

The 151 computers will be leased rather than sold to the Air Force. Lease cost, when all the systems are installed, will be approximately \$4.9 million annually.

The Air Force said: "It should be noted however."

The Air Force said: "It should be noted, however, that we expect the cost of this equipment to be more than offset by a release of punched card accounting machines and by anticipated savings over a period of time."

Major components of the equipment will be manufactured at Burroughs facilities in Plymouth and Pasadena, Calif. with assembly of the systems being accomplished in Pasadena.


