

Wonderland Center Offer Cash-Trophies

Plans for the first amateur combo contest ever staged in this area were announced this week by Ernie Epps, promotion director for Wonderland Center. The contest, open to high-school-age band groups in Livonia, Garden City, Redford, Farmington, Plymouth and Northville, will be held in conjunction with the center's fifth anniversary celebration in October.

A \$100 cash prize will go to the musical group selected as the most outstanding. Trophies and other prizes will be awarded to runners-up, Epps said. The contest will be under the direction of Don Mills, one of Detroit's best-known musicians. Amateur band groups must register before Sept. 26, Mills said.

The grand-prize winners will be announced. A series of auditions will be staged at Wonderland to select finalists, he added. Final judging will begin Oct. 12 and Mills emphasized that contest entrants must be non-professional and of high-school age. Application to enter the contest must be in the form of a letter containing name of group, number of musicians and name of school they attend. Auditions will be held at Wonderland on Saturdays.
