

# U-M Graduates Sought By U.S. Business And Industry

ANN ARBOR — Degree recipients from The University of Michigan Graduate School of Business Administration continue to be eagerly sought by United States business and industry.

During the past academic year more than 300 top companies in the nation sent recruiters to the U-M Business School. They scheduled more than 450 visits during the placement program in which 245 of the school's 318 candidates for the Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree participated as did 69 of the 180 candidates for the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree.

Starting salaries for MBA recipients ranged as high as \$11,750 per month, with the median at \$5,750.

Among the BBA candidates, salaries ranged up to \$7,150 a month, with median at \$5,600. These figures have been revealed by S. A. Hann, who directs placement activities for the U-M Business School. The most active recruitment during the year, Hann has pointed out, was in the fields of accounting, banking, corporation finance, marketing, actuarial science and quantitative methods.

"Demand was well above supply in these areas as well as in several other fields,"

Hann states.

"This was the greatest recruitment year for our graduates we have ever experienced," he declares. In all categories—number of companies, number of interviews, students participating, job placements and salaries—new records were established.

Hann points out that less than half of the BBA candidates registered for placement. A majority of them continue their education, mainly at the U-M, until they earn their MBA degrees.

"We are especially proud of the high caliber of companies that make annual recruitment visits to our campus," the Business School placement director states.

"The blue ribbon character of these firms underlines the

strong reputation the U-M Graduate School of Business Administration enjoys in the nation's business circles."

Business School Dean Floyd A. Bond points out that "The increase in our school's enrollment and the high quality of

candidates is eloquent testimony to the attraction of a curriculum geared to today's needs, a faculty of the highest order, and unsurpassed placement opportunities."

During the past year the placement office made a study

of the factors determining job selection by the school's graduates. At the top of the list for both MBA and BBA candidates was "type of work," while "opportunity for future growth" ranked second.

MBA candidates put "salary level" in third place, followed by "type of industry," "type of people" and "location." BBA candidates ranked "location" third, "salary level" fourth, "size of company" fifth, and "type of industry" sixth.
