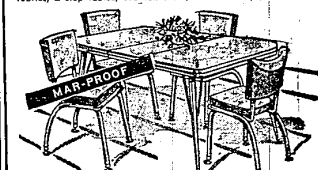

Many clubs have done over 50 benefit shows in a year's time for the less fortunate, according to George Koehnke, founder of the organization.

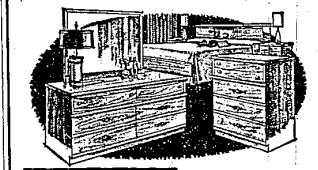

Precinct Delegates March for Farnum

More than 200 men and women will march through the 19th Congressional District Saturday to promote the candidacy of Billie S. Farnum, Democratic candidate for Congress.

The district includes the cities of Livonia, Northville and Pontiac, Redford Township and Western Wayne County.

"This drive is necessitated by the fact that the major newspapers in the district are on strike, and it is important that the voters be acquainted with Mr. Farnum's merits," stated Charles McPhee, coordinator for the March in Oakland County. Donald McCheslen will lead the march in Wayne County.

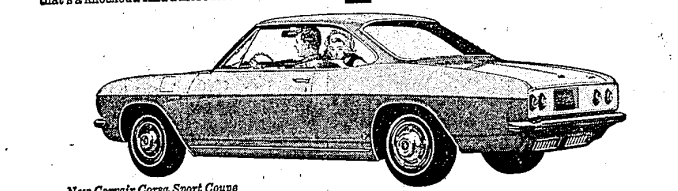
