Mothers Organize New Co-Op Nursery

Because Mrs. Julie Ryden wants her three-year-old daughter Becky to go to nursery school next fall, a new cooperative nursery is being organized in the Plymouth area.

She and 19 other mothers are looking for a place to hold classes for pre-schoolers. They also are seeking a teacher.

"We hope to get started by October," said Mrs. Ryden, who took on the organizing job although she's expecting her third child in a few months.

"I decided it was the only way my children would be able to go," she explained.

Organizers of the new cooperative will meet July 30 at 7:30 p.m. in the home of Mrs. Donna Pearce, 44529 Marc Trail, Plymouth. They hope to adopt a constitution and elect officers then, and all mothers interested are invited to join them.

Mrs. Ryden and her family moved to Plymouth from California in February.

She knew about cooperatives, in which parents help an accredited teacher, and

decided that was what she wanted for Becky and Annamarie.

But when she called the Plymouth's Children's Nursery, which operates an extensive program in an old schoolhouse at Warren and Haggerty, she found its membership closed for all four seasons.

"They said they couldn't even add everyone to the waiting list," she said. "But they asked if I would be interested in starting up a new nursery. I said I guessed I'd have to if I wanted my children to go."

Mrs. Ryden put a couple of notices on the bulletin boards of Plymouth supermarkets, and there was quick response from 19 families.

Organization was started at a meeting a few weeks ago.

Now a location is needed and a teacher is being sought. Suggestions for either may be telephoned to Mrs. Frederick Webb, 43327 Hartford, Plymouth. Prospective new members also may telephone Mrs. Webb.

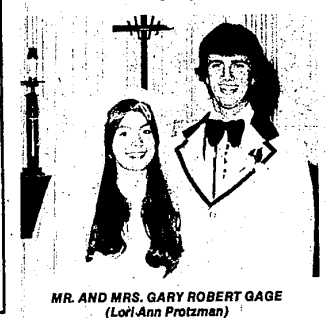
