**Thanksgiving Cranberry Sauce**  
Mary Tallard  
1 pkg. fresh cranberries  
2 whole oranges  
2 C. sugar  
2 small diced celery  
2 C. chopped nuts  
2 pkgs. yellow (1 lemon and 1 red  
3 C. water.

Cut oranges into pieces, skin and all and put through meat grinder along with 1 pkg. cranberries. Add 2 C. sugar, mix well and over.
