Wayne and Oakland County registered m or e than 10,000 new dwelling units during the first nine months of this year. For Wayne County, outside of Detroit, new homes totaled 4,919. This included 3,947 single family units, ten two-family units and 223 home demolitions. In Cokkland County that and 223 home demolitions there is the constructed, 32 two-family units, 2,472 multi-family units, 2,472 multi-family units, and 386 demolitions of homes. Oakland County registered a 14.1 per cent gain in new home construction over the same ninemonth period last year, while Wayne County (excluding Detroit) showed an 18.6 per cent hike.
