

NBD Reports Earnings

Net operating earnings of National Bank of Detroit for the nine months ended Sept. 30, 1964, were \$15,241,020, or \$3.81 per share, it was reported by Henry T. Bodman, chairman, and George E. Parker, Jr., president.

This compares with \$13,457,206, or \$3.38 per share, for the corresponding period of 1963, based on 4,000,000 shares outstanding since payment of an 11 1/2 per cent stock dividend in January, 1964.

Total resources were \$2,682,702,853, an increase of \$322,370,231 over a year ago. Total deposits were \$2,409,859,594 which is an increase of \$275,784,224. Savings and time deposits totaled \$949,460,768 and showed a gain of \$156,547,819. Loans and mortgages at \$1,074,529,128, were up \$145,415,714. Holdings of United States securities, totaling \$608,882,256, were \$18,707,088 lower, while other securities, at \$385,189,584, were \$63,220,585 higher than the figure of Sept. 30 last year.

Total capital funds of the bank were \$196,543,254 on Sept. 30, reflecting an increase of \$9,282,080 in the last 12 months.

Former Redford Teacher Aids Physically Handicapped Children

James Greiner, Special Education Consultant, has been employed by the Wayne County Intermediate Office of Education to serve all 43 school districts in developing programs for physically handicapped students.

During the past ten years, Jim Greiner has been active working with physically handicapped children. He initiated the new orthopedic-candiac program at Eccles, Michigan, and directed it for five years. While

at South Redford school district as a teacher-counselor for the physically handicapped, Jim established an activity center for the children and started an Orthopedic Parents Council. Mr. Greiner was selected three times by the Easter Seal Society of Western Wayne County to be the Director of their day camp. While completing his Master's Degree at Wayne State University Jim did research work at Merrill-Palmer in nursery education.

School districts will be able to receive the benefit of his training and experience without charge. The Wayne County Intermediate Office of Education offers twenty such consultants to the local school districts to provide assistance in the establishing and improving of school programs.

Greiner is a member of the Michigan Council for Exceptional Children, the Delta Kappa and the National Rehabilitation Association. He has also served for four years on the State Curriculum Committee for Exceptional Children.
