CURTAIN GOING UP

"There has been nothing in human history which has brought mankind closer to the realization of an infinite creativity than the revelation that the minutest particles of matter contain an almost immeasurable power."

Who said this? Archibald MacLeish, author of the Pulitzer Prize Drama "J. B.", in answering objections that Job's story bears no relationship to our own since science now knows that there is no Creator.

Wayne State's superb production of "J. B." completely obliterates any further notions you might have about the absence of a Creator.

Bryan Hill and Mat Reitz caper about the stage with the ease of actors knowing exactly what the roles call for. They play symbolically of course, God and Satan. Their philosophical diatribes offer ample evidence of a divine being.

A few years back Basil Rathbone came to Detroit in the Satan role. Christopher Plummer had done the part on Broadway. To ask Basil to whirl and almost dance the role was almost an impossibility in the first place. Rathbone's bones were beginning to creak somewhat embarrassingly.

Mat Reitz enacted the role of the playing Satan skillfully, smoothly and so satisfyingly that I almost saw the ghost of Christopher Plummer hovering over his left shoulder all evening. In fact, the entire production had that eerie penetrating power that fascinates you and draws you irresistibly into the drama.

"J. B.", powerfully staged by Robert Hazard, once more reaffirmed my faith in the University Theatre Group. Technically, as always at the Bonstelle, the production was a delight to behold, adding electric power and moving significance to this verse drama built around the Book of Job.

The long list of characters from Michael Landrum to Dennis Brown, in the minor role of a preacher, gave impressive support to the two brilliant leads. Everyone in the cast performed ably and made "J. B." a special occasion in the theater.

Thurston High's Dave Donchick had a featured role in "J. B." His versatility was evident as he undertook four different roles. His early career at Redford's Thurston prepared him most ably. Pat Secor, his Thurston mentor, must feel proud to see Dave doing so well. Old Wally always enjoys seeing that effective early training on the high school level has been.

During the early snowstorm of last week, I slipped and slid down to the Wyandotte-Roosevelt High School to see a high school production of "Inherit the Wind." My daughter who accompanied me thought I was out of my skull to go that distance to see a high school play.

Many high school plays are disastrous. Many of them hardly deserve to be exhibited to the public. Of course, exceptions to the rule do crop up like welcome oases. And what makes the difference?

Michigan's 36th Freeway scheduled to be opened by the Safety Rest Area was opened recently.

The Rest Area, located on I-75 three miles south of M-57 in Genesee County, serves south-bound traffic.

It is one of five Freeway Safety Rest Areas being built on I-75 and US-10 Freeways between Pontiac and Midland. The other four Rest Areas are scheduled to be opened by the end of the year.

Freeway Rest Areas are located on eight acres of land, having parking facilities for 50 cars and 20 trucks and are equipped with rest rooms, telephones, drinking water and an informational bulletin board.
