The Plymouth Theatre Guild opened its 1964-65 season last weekend with a production of the comedy "Harvey". This comedy is noteworthy mainly because of the fact that the protagonist and scene stealer is never seen by the human. That is, he is never seen unless you are one of the select.

"Harvey" is the protagonist naturally (otherwise why would the play be named in honor of him). The only problem is that Harvey is a 6-foot white rabbit who allows himself to be seen by a few selected elite.

In spite of this handicap he stole the show at the Plymouth High School last weekend. Giving the audience here a battle for the unseen hero's attention was his boon companion, Elwood P. Dowd, as portrayed by Jacob W. Rumpf.

Once these two characters (which may be either in the traditional or colloquial meaning of the word) made their entrance, the pace of the play picked up considerably. They dominated the stage.

Five supporting performances were turned in by Carl Nelson, Ellen McNiece, Helen Fortney, Effie Kuisel and Norma Lovelless.

The only question remaining is whether or not the Guild can surpass Harvey's dominance in future productions.
