

August Workshops Are Announced

DETROIT The Detroit Historical Museum has planned a number of workshops, programs and exhibits during August.

On Saturday afternoons an old time movie will be shown. No admission.

An Indian basket making workshop will be from Aug. 7-10 for children eight to 12 years old. Those enrolling in the class will use natural materials to make baskets and hear lectures on how early settlers used them. Reservations are required.

A historic shopping spree will be for youngsters, eight to 12 years old from Aug. 14-17. The children will be making canisters using advertisements from the 1830's to 1930's for decorations. They will also get the opportunity to shop on the historical street at the museum.

A needlecraft workshop for beginning adults will be Aug. 2, 7 and 14. Registration is required. Areas to be covered will be crewel embroidery, crochet, and needlepoint.

On Aug. 15 a lecture will be given on the life style of early homemakers. There will be demonstrations on how to make butter, candles, soap, and writing with a quill pen.

A quilting workshop will be held from Aug. 21-23 and Aug. 29-30. Registrants will learn the basic elements of quilting, pattern design, historic patterns, sewing procedure and finishing. All materials to create a quilted pillow will be provided.

A history of sewing will be presented on Aug. 9. Mother and daughter participation is encouraged. Reservations are required.

There will be ice cream socials on Aug. 5 and the 19 from 1:30 p.m. to 3 p.m. Demonstrations on how to make home-made ice cream will be presented. Recipes will also be distributed.

Detroit's historic Fort Wayne and Canada's Fort Malden will be toured Aug. 18. There will also be discussions on Fort Pontchartrain and Fort Lernoult. Reservations are required.

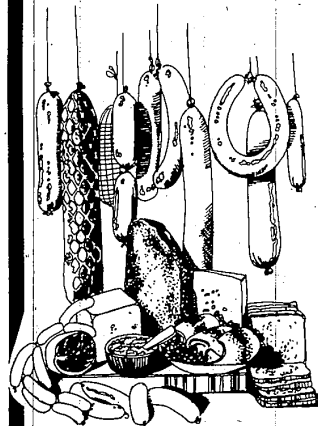
Admission to the show is free, but there is a 50-cent charge for parking.

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
