Plan Lists Local Pair

HOUGHTON Designing a bridge, creating a radio program, digging for past civilizations, testing a lake for pollution or putting out a forest fire may sound like heady operations for high school students.

But that was the action on the Michigan Technological University campus July 8-21 when nearly 530 youths from 19 states and Canada participated in the summer youth program, "Explorations in Careers and Knowledge." Included were Tammy Stevens of 17303 Dolores, Livonia, and Kyle Carrothers of 19580 Northbrook, Southfield.

With the accent on "doing things" rather than "hearing about things," the specially-designed series of 24 intensive one- and two-week programs gave students a

chance to learn about and acquire skills in the fields which interest them.

Directed by Dr. Calvin W. Gale, director of teacher education and professor of education at Michigan Tech, and led by instructors who are experts in their fields, the "hand's on" explorations were offered in these areas of study.

Gerald Montry Gets New Post

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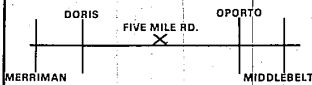
