## Dr. Conrad Lam to Conduct Franklin Village Band

The distinguished thirty-two piece Franklin Village Band, under the direction of Dr. Conrad R. Lam, Chief, Department of Thoracic Surgery, Ford Hospital, Detroit, will present outstanding works of the Band Music at the State Hospital in Pontiac tonight (Thursday evening, December 10) at 8 p.m. Dr. Lam is a resident of Wood Creek Farm Village in Farmington Township.

The engagement this year will be the third annual appearance of the area brass, woodwind and percussion instrumentalists.

SELECTIONS For the one hour Christmas Program will include: Christmas Medleys, rousing marches by John Philip Sousa and Wagner; "First Movement" From Symphony in B Minor No. 8 - "The Pastoral" by Franz Schubert; "Columbia Fantasia Polka" cornet solo by Ron Nighthale; concertmaster of the band; "The Post and Pansy" Overture by F. Von Suppe, and closes with "Baron & Bailey's Favorites" by K. L. King.

Arrangements for the appearance of the group from the southern part of Oakland County were made through the Recreational Therapy Department of the hospital and officers of the band. Clinician and president of the band, Bill Ellison, states firmly that the date at Pontiac State Hospital is fully appreciated and enthusiastically audience. "THE DODGE BOYS" IN FARMINGTON

"Unfortunately, there are several ways to prepare the family car for another winter of driving," was the somewhat surprising observation of Farmington Township Police Chief Irving Yakes in a pre-winter statement today.

"One way is to drive your car to any station in sight and tell the attendant to give it a winter 'grease-job' and oil change," the chief said. "This method I don't happen to approve, and if any car owner thinks it's none of my business, I probably owe him an explanation as to why I think it is."

THE CHIEF THEN explained his department's responsibility for keeping traffic moving safely and smoothly in all kinds of winter weather. In time of emergency, he pointed out, this could mean life or death—possibly for the very one whose car might break down in traffic because neither it nor its driver was really ready for winter.

"The better way to winterize," the chief advised, "is to take your car to a reputable garage with instructions to take care of everything—no matter how insignificant it may seem—that has anything to do with your ability to keep that car moving in cold weather."

First, instead of a casual winter change-over, a complete engine tune-up, and an inspection from fan belt to tailpipe, is in order, according to Chief Yakes. "Some new drivers, and even some of the older ones, you'd be surprised, don't seem to realize this," he said.

"And don't forget," continued the chief, "the sweetest engine in town can't move you far if your wheels are spinning on snow or ice. They may spin because the tread has disappeared from old tires, or you haven't had the forethought to install snow tires and have a good set of reinforced tire chains in your car trunk, ready to work for you."

FARMINGTON'S winter safety record is on the line, and that's another reason why Chief Yakes urges that a car's pre-winter conditioning program should be "complete."

The same can be said of windshield wipers, he warns. If the blade rubber is already brittle and streaking, or if the wiper arms do not apply the recommended pressure of one ounce for each inch of blade length, a winter driver can find himself "lost between here and the next corner, so far as safe driving is concerned." The result can be anything from stalled traffic to a tragic accident.

"If you lose, we lose; and if we lose, so do you," the chief concluded. "We need each other, drivers and police officers, all doing our best, to meet a tough winter on even terms."
