Bright Shiny Beads

Fashion for Fall '73 is a clean, put-together look ... soft classics that provide a perfect background for exciting jewelry.

Beads, beads, beads ... round beads, oval beads, graduated beads, tiny uniform beads, faceted beads—to be worn with any neckline any time of the day or night.

Soft slinky chains ... all widths of snake chains in copper, sliver and gold, fine chains, open link chains, and long and short chains with a single head or motif.

Chunky chokers worn inside an open shirt with longer lengths worn outside ... lengths that go all the way from 16" chokers to the newest 43" length or about an inch below the waist ... in bright polished beads, satin finished beads of silver, gold and copper-color, opaque deep shades of burgandy, green, brown and grey, opalescent moonstone beads, faceted crystals in clear, jet, pale jonquil to deepest amber, tourmaline to dark emerald, shades of amethyst, rose to deep ruby. And the clear, clean contemporary look of clear lucite beads and objects with touches of silver and gold.

Bracelets are another important part of the fashion picture ... narrow bracelets to be worn in multiples ... or mixed with medium widths ... wide bracelets worn alone ... bracelets on both arms. Bangles covered in an endless range of colors of natural cobra ... bangles and cuffs in tortoise, horn, burgandy, deep green, bright red, camel, jet ... round and square bangles in clear lucite ... enameled bracelets ... wrap-around bracelets in polished gold and silver, silver and copper,

with insets of natural cobra or enamel.

The earring for Fall '73 is the BIG button-round, square, flat, ball, oval or domed, polished and shiny or textured and satin-finished ... enameled or with cobra insets, cobra with a dot of rhinestone, gold or silver-round buttons of faceted crystals in a spectrum of colors ... opaque dome buttons in the rich, deep fall colors, oval buttons in clear lucite and postage stamp square crystal rhinestone.
