Low Density Multiple Text Proposed

The text for a low density, multiple family residential zoning district in the Township was approved for public hearing by the Township Zoning Board at a regular meeting on March 25.

The text additions, requested by the Board at their February meeting, were prepared by Vilcan Leman, planning consultants. The request was that a district be established at a density of 10 dwelling units per acre, but the planners submitted a "more comprehensive multiple housing provision" which included three densities "to provide a more adequate range of densities to be utilized to meet varying needs."

After considerable discussion the board approved the recommended text. Under the proposal, the present R-3, two family district for which there has been no requests in over

two years, will be eliminated. All R-C multiple districts will be replaced by RC-1, 7 dwellings per acre, RC-2, 10 dwellings per acre, and RC-3, 14 dwellings per acre.

Principal and special approval uses are spelled out in the text as well as lot sizes, building heights, yard set-

backs, total floor area and other requirements.

Present R-C zones without plot plan approval will be rezoned to RC-3 and those with plot plan approval will be rezoned to RC-3.

The proposed ordinance changes have been set for public hearing on April 22.
