

# Bike Trip Will Cross 'Mac'

The Dick Allen Lansing to Mackinaw Bicycle Tour has extended the registration deadline for the trip to Aug. 15. The four-day ride begins Aug. 30.

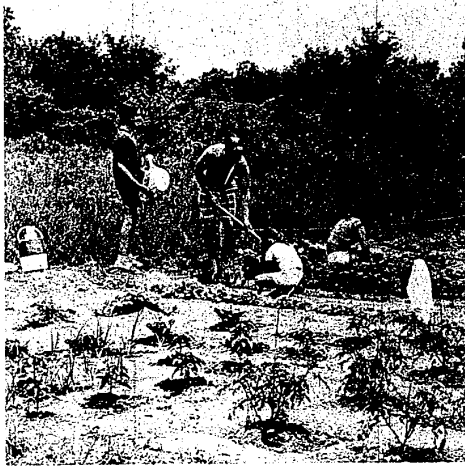
The event, named for former State Rep. Richard Allen of Ithaca, originated in 1971 and was designed to bring favorable attention to pending bicycle legislation.

For the first time, permission has been granted for the cyclists to cross the bridge.

The involvement of Helen Miliken, the governor's wife, and Jane Hart, U.S. Sen. Philip Hart's wife, helped clear the way for the bridge crossing.

More than 225 persons have signed up for the 285-mile ride so far, coming from as far away as New Hampshire and ranging in age from 13 to 70.
