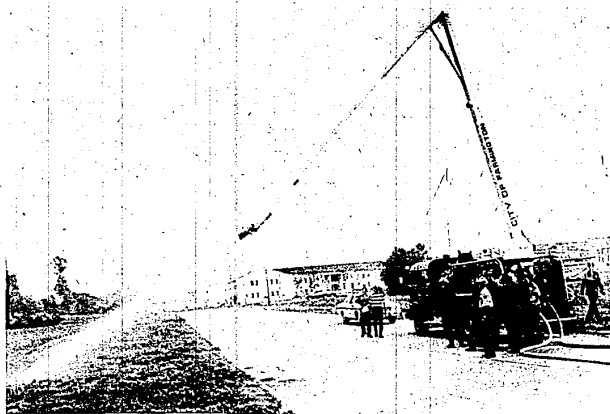


City, Hills Firemen Join Forces For Drill

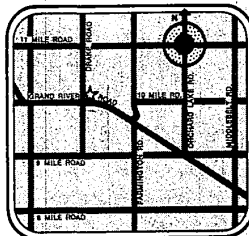
