**Many View Refuse Exhibit**

Delos Hamlin, Farmington resident, chairman of the Oakland County Board of Supervisors and vice chairman of Metropolitan Fund, Inc., expressed pleasure with an exhibit displaying the regional concept of refuse disposal for Southeast Michigan which was displayed last week in the lobby of the Oakland County Board Supervisors Auditorium, Detroit.

**THE EXHIBIT** was provided by Metropolitan Fund, Inc., an urban affairs foundation which researches projects to help resolve metropolitan problems. The display consisted of a large relief map identifying disposal facilities for local counties.

**New Car Wash Site Needed**

A new location to hold benefit and fund raising car washes other than the northeast corner of the Downtown Center parking lot that has been used frequently by various clubs and organizations in the past will now have to be found.

Action on the recommendation of the city manager and public safety director, the City Council took official action on April 19 on a policy which will forbid the use of this location for car washes by any organizations or clubs in the future. It was emphasized that this action was deemed necessary because of increased traffic congestion that has resulted since additional stores have been added at the east end of the Downtown Farmington Center.

Boy Scout Troop 118 which had a benefit car wash scheduled for this location was agreeable to re-scheduling it for early May and having the car wash at the Flanders School site if Farmington School Board approval can be obtained.

The Young Republicans Club also had a request pending for use of the parking lot for a car wash. Officials of the club will now be notified that this location is no longer available and advised to attempt to obtain use of a school parking lot area.
