## Quakertown Questers Make Convention Plans

Quakertown Chapter of the Questers held their monthly meeting at the home of hostess, Mrs. Robert Mock, 28410 Newcastle, Farmington, on Wednesday, April 28.

An excellent study report was prepared by Mrs. George Kuzmanovich on "Currier & Ives." It was learned that a disastrous fire on a steamboat in 1840 started Nathaniel Currier on his way to becoming a National Illustrator.

Fifty days after the flaming ship, the Lexington, went down, a finely drawn and realistic print of the event was issued. The publication was entitled "The Extra Sun" and at the lower right hand corner of the print appeared the words "N. Currier, Lithographer and Publisher."

A FEW YEARS LATER James M. Ives was hired as a bookkeeper and fitted so well into the rapidly expanding firm that after five years, in 1857, he was made a partner — thus began the famous "Currier & Ives." For illustration Mrs. Kuzmanovich submitted the famous "Winter Scene" from her own collection.

Mrs. Dana Freeman, president of this group, informed the members of the final plans for the National Convention of the Questers which is scheduled for May 4, 5 and 6 at Dearborn, Michigan.

Mrs. Oliver D. Hanna of Harrison, Michigan, the National Quester President has delegated important convention responsibilities to two Michigan Questers. Mrs. A. Lowensbury, President of the Pontchartrain Chapter has been named Official Convention Hostess.
