## Twp. Police Ord. Amended

The Farmington Township Board took action Monday night, April 26, amending present ordinance provisions which make it mandatory that written examinations be given to all policemen being considered for promotions.

It was explained during discussion that this placed somewhat hard to comply with restriction on the supervisor since tests for experienced officers of the law were not readily available to be used. Point was made of the fact that all policemen are given a thorough exam at the time they hire onto the force anyway and that grades well above normal are required before a man can even get on the township force.

Supervisor Hall pointed out that in the case of promoting men with four or five years experience or more in police work more emphasis was placed on their character, work record and ability to get along than on any testing grades anyway.

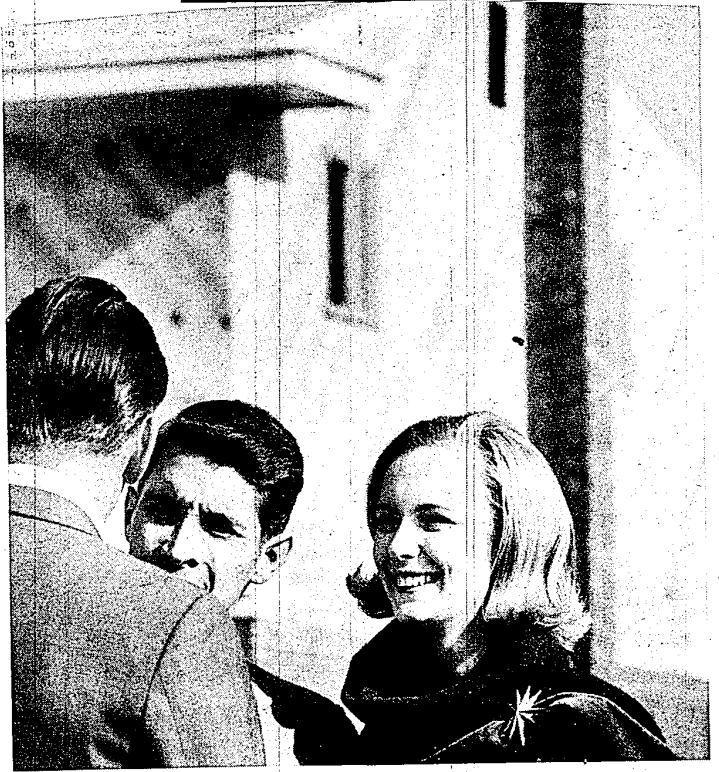
