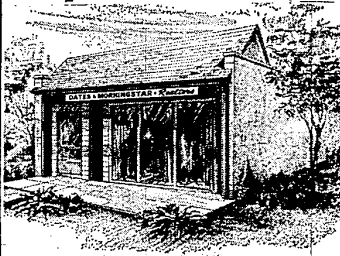

FARMINGTON HIGH football coach Jack Hayes and his wife, Janet, are looking forward to a busy schedule this summer at the "Joy Camps for Girls" in Hazelhurst, Wisconsin where they are owner and directors. The Hayes' make their home at 3334 Oakland Avenue in Farmington and have five youngsters of their own, operate the Joy Camps for girls between the ages of seven and seventeen on a full eight-week program which includes learning aquatic skills, horseback riding, camping and boating and many other activities.

Summer Camp For Girls Opened By Farmington Man and Wife Team

With the approach of summer vacation from the public schools Farmington area girls between seven and seventeen again have the chance to spend their vacation at a Northern Wisconsin summer camp owned and operated by a local husband and wife team. Mr. and Mrs. John F. Hayes, owners-directors of the Joy

Camps near Hazelhurst, Wisconsin, are now accepting applications for eight weeks of activities and instruction. The enrollment this summer is limited to sixty girls. THE JOY CAMPS, divided into the Deepwater and the Pioneer for older and younger girls, is situated on Raymond Lake providing for all sorts of water activities and instruction under counselor supervision.

Each camper may choose her daily program activities which may range from horse back riding along forest lanes and canoeing down the Wisconsin River to camping and hiking to historical places near the wilderness camps.

The campers also have the opportunity to learn the skills of archery, water safety and boating under the supervision of the staff counselors. Six sleeping cabins are provided for the campers, and accommodations for ten girls and three counselors. There is also a registered nurse on duty at all times, and health checks are made daily.

MR. HAYES, director of the camp, has been a teacher and coach in the Farmington school system for many years. The Hayes' live at 3334 Oakland in Farmington with their five children, Michael, Mary Beth, Julie, Jane and Patricia.

The Joy Camps is registered as a member of the American Camping Association which certifies it as meeting high standards in safety, cleanliness and staff.

Fairgame III is one of a series of combined French and U.S. naval exercises which have been conducted annually for French and U.S. forces.
