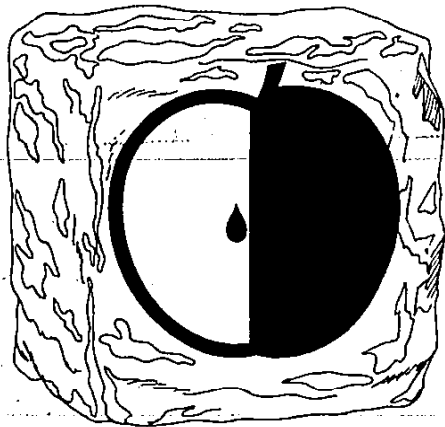
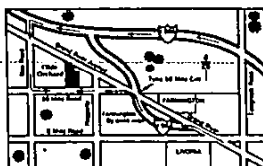

Are You Making A Smart Move?

Moving? Do you know what you are about?

Whether this is your first move, or your last (you hope, you hope), selecting a moving company strictly on the basis of the lowest bidder is not necessarily the best way to save money.

Except for local moves, the price which is figured on the weight of your household goods and the distance they are to be moved will be the same regardless of which moving company does the job.

LOCAL MOVES are those within a city or village, as well as those between a city or village and any point within a radius of approximately eight miles. Such local moves are not regulated and the mover can set the price and vary the services offered.

There is one exception: moves between Detroit and another city within eight miles are regulated by the Michigan Public Service Commission.

The rates, tariffs and charges for non-local moves in Michigan are regulated by the Michigan Public Service Commission; those from one state to another are regulated by the Interstate Commerce Commission.

This regulation does not merely

permit the moving company to charge a certain amount but actually requires the company to charge neither more nor less than that amount.

As a result, if you are making a local move, you might be able to get a better price from one mover than from another. With respect to all other moves, the price you pay will be the same regardless of the estimates.

It is, however, a good idea to get some estimates and to discuss the incidental services offered by moving companies, such as crating, putting breakables in barrels, etc.

This way, particularly if you tend to rely on the high estimates rather than the low ones, you will get an idea of how much the move is going to cost, and you will be able to decide ahead of time which of your things need protection or special handling and be able to make arrangements accordingly. You might also be able to form an opinion about which moving company appears to be more trustworthy and reliable.
