## City Starts Move For Fire Marshal

To bolster its public safety department and provide additional precautions against heavy fire losses in the future the City of Farmington

has taken steps to create a position of Fire Marshal.

This action came last Monday night on the recommendation of Capt. Daniel Byrnes of the public safety department who called attention to the present manpower shortage and the need for a fire marshal to keep intact the city's low crime rate and fire protection record.

In his recommendation Capt. Byrnes stated that for the past 3 1/2 months two members of the department have been lost because of sickness and injury.

Because of this, many adjustments have had to be made, even to the point of canceling vacations.

He asked that he be allowed to employ one additional officer to fill these present vacancies and that, upon the return of the men, to create the new position of fire marshal within the department.

Council immediately approved with the under-

standing that the fire marshal, when appointed, would have the responsibility of conducting all in-service fire training, conducting commercial and industrial fire safety inspections and coordinating with the building department the review of construction plans for fire safety requirements.

He also will be empowered to develop a volunteer fire department and a city wide fire prevention program.

The cost of establishing the office and the employment of another cadet was estimated at \$12,500.

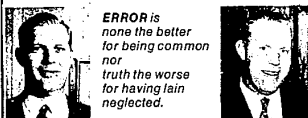
