



Christian Day School To Open

A new day school with "the principles of God and country" as its foundations will open Sept. 5 in the Forest Hills Church of Farmington.

According to students, grades kindergarten through 12 and staffed by three full-time instructors and several aides, it will follow the curriculum of Accelerated Christian Education, a program developed in Texas five years ago.

Opening the school means fulfilling a dream long held by the Rev. Harold Belgie, pastor of Forest Hills.

He said he and others in his congregation, affiliated with the Missionary denomination, long have felt that "people need the principles of God and country, and our young people are not getting these in the public schools."
