# Entertainment Group Recast

Clarenceville Entertainment Series, Inc. is now operating under a reorganized structure which includes a formal board of directors and list of officers.

The non-profit group was organized from the former Auditorium Planning Commission set up to increase auditorium use by booking events there. Originally the group was under the auspices of the Clarenceville School Board.

Although "sanctioned" by the board, the new group is not legally connected with the board and still works with the same goals, according to a group spokesman.

Officers of the group are: Frank Lozano, president; Janet Graffe, vice-president; Raymond Chaiken, treasurer; Bonnie Garrison, recording secretary; Lee Tornberg, corresponding secretary.

Board of directors are: Fran Chaiken, Jim Garrison, Tom Wilson, Barbara Lozano and Suzanne Rosko.

Raymond Chaiken and Wilson are also school board members.

"The board of directors was formed from a group of people who originally decided to organize on our own," explained Mrs. Lozano. "We elected officers from among ourselves."

Involved with booking and promoting performances for the auditorium group since its conception, Midge Ellis will continue in the same capacity. Now, however, she will receive a 50 cent commission on each ticket sold. Formerly her work was done without charge. Capacity for the auditorium is more than 900 seats.

"I am still doing booking and promoting and I am still a member of the group," explained Mrs. Ellis. "Now I will be getting paid for the work I did which sometimes took 12-13 hours a day, every day."

"My work includes getting the bands, price, haggling with them, the sale of tickets and press releases and ar-

range for radio and television personalities to appear," she continued.

Mrs. Ellis emphasized that the same type of performances would be scheduled now as in the past such as big bands, children's plays and musical clinics.

Although tickets last year sold for \$2-\$2.50, this year the price will increase to \$3-\$4.

"Band prices have gone up because of increasing living expenses on the road," according to Mrs. Ellis. "The price of the ticket will depend on who is appearing and the group's price."

"Overage (profits) on bands will be used to cover the cost of kids' programs. We try to keep the price of their tickets low at 50 cents-\$1," she continued.

According to Mrs. Ellis, the only difference in the operation of the non-profit corporation is that "the school is no longer liable if we ever lost money. We have never lost money, but we sign our own contracts."

The group is still granted the use of the Louis E. Schmidt Auditorium, according to board policy. Supt. David McDowell said that the organization is not charged for the use of the auditorium with the exception of "heat, lights, custodial charges, things of that nature, excessive wear or damage."
