Crow's Nest Mayflower Has New Look

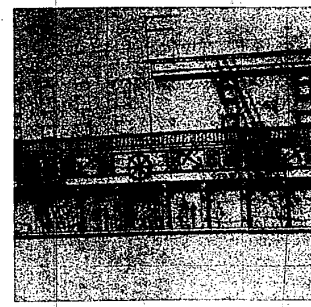

Avast ye, mates.
For restaurateurs who wish to bathe in the atmosphere of 17th century sea life, they may now journey to nautic Plymouth and enjoy

the Mayflower Hotel's new est lounge, "The Crow's Nest."
Replete with mermaid and pewter mugs, the restaurant is being designed from stem to stern, with the facelift including redecoration of the outside south wall of the hotel in appropriate style.
Mayflower management has been working since April in conjunction with Graham and Colotta architects in the \$100,000 project.
"It was inspired by a trip to our sister city, Plymouth, England," says Ralph Lorenz, Mayflower owner.
"We visited a lot of English pubs and decided to redecorate in order to capture the spirit they offered."
Scheduled for full operation by the Plymouth Fall Festival which opens Sept. 5, the restaurant's kitchen has been expanded to accommodate the additional 30-customer capacity.
Patrons are greeted by a cannon off the flagpole of Admiral Lord Nelson which decorates the lobby. Only four such cannons exist.
On entering the dimly lit area, diners will immediately feel the spirit upon seeing the Crow's Nest ably manned by a mermaid which served formerly as a ship's decoration.
Walls are decorated with ships rigging, handcarved miniatures of seaman imported from Germany and a special wall of autographed log ends from around the world.
"The autograph idea was started after the Lord Mayor of Plymouth, England, visited the community and autographed one of the logs. Now we have signatures from people who have visited from all over the world," says Lorenz.
Adding to the atmosphere

is a group of dock piling set off in the corner. Lighting is primarily provided by ship's lanterns. Naturally, no sea-room would be complete without a ship's wheel and the "Crow's Nest" is no exception.
Handwoven timbers adorn the ceilings which complete the feeling of being below board in some ancient galleon.
Keeping the ale extra cold are numerous pewter mugs hung along the wall behind the bar.
Visitors will be fooled by the old-fashioned ice box located behind the bar which is actually operated by electricity.
Plans are in the process to open a steak room opposite the "Crow's Nest," but as of yet are incomplete because of the beef shortage.
A NEW LOOK is being given the Mayflower Hotel in Plymouth because of the opening of the "The Crow's Nest," a restaurant decorated in the fashion of a 17th century English pub.



Restaurant Story Is Explained

In a restaurant review of Aug. 11 in the Observer's amusement section, a reader expressed the joy of experiencing Chinese food in its proper form after some incidents of "stale egg rolls and sloppy bean sprouts."

The suburban area has some of the finest Chinese restaurants in the United States, a fact realized by the reviewer. The restaurant reviewed is a gracious addition. Those restaurants serving equally fine food shouldn't be concerned.
The criticism fits only those who don't live up to standard Chinese food. Names need not be mentioned. They know who they are.
