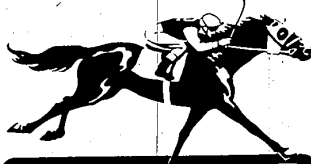




FOLLOWING THROUGH with a shot in Championship tennis action at Stevenson High is Cathy Struthers. (Observer photo)

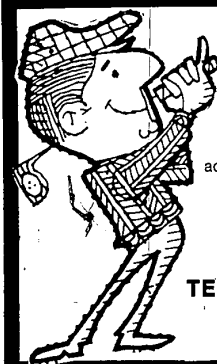

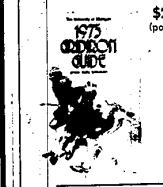

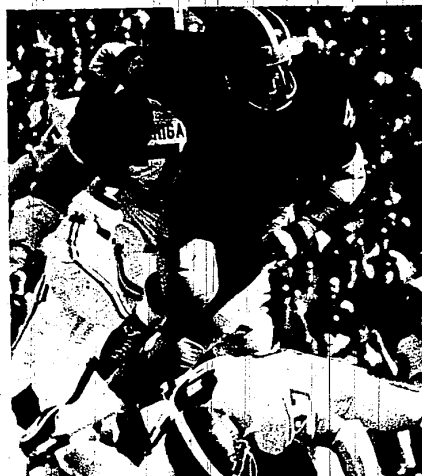
