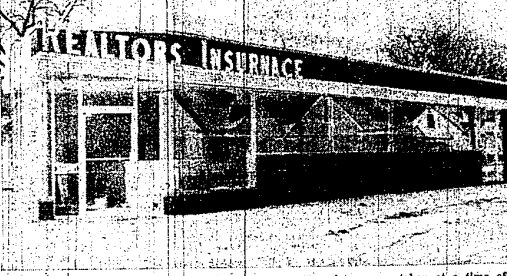

Alien Reports Due in January

Walter A. Sahli, District Director of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, advised today that the annual alien admissibility program is again getting under way.

According to Sahli, 168,000 aliens reported their addresses last year in the State of Michigan. The number this year is expected to be slightly larger.

Sahli attributes this anticipated increase to additional persons coming to the State of Michigan. The Immigration official pointed out that the address reports are required by law and without failure to comply with these requirements may lead to serious consequences.

Forms with which to make the reports are available at the Offices and Immigration Office. It is an easy matter to fill out one of the cards and return it to the same office.

Mr. Sahli added that training personnel will be on hand in all Immigration Offices to answer any questions the reporting aliens may have regarding immigration and naturalization matters. Sufficient trained personnel are not available to furnish this service in all Post Offices.
