

Think Your Tax Bill is High? - Look at Bell's  
Michigan Bell Telephone Company announced its payment to the state primary school fund for 1954. The largest in the company's history.

Amounting to \$12,498,000, the payment again placed Michigan Bell as the top contributor to the fund. John Kamago, manager here for the company, reported that \$4,111 of the total tax payment was allocated to the public school system of Farmington. Schools throughout Oakland county received from Michigan Bell's payment a total of \$1,106,645. Payments were based on the county census of 175,943, the local school census of 7,013. The tax payment amounted to \$6.29 for each of the 1,989,229 consumers in the state between the ages of 5 and 19 who were on the census rolls for the 1954-55 school year.
