Commercial on Grand River Is Not Approved

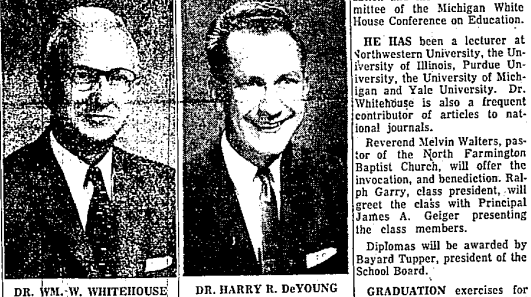
